Most people are using some type of a shad imitation for most of the day but in the early morning and late evening the bigger lures are starting to catch bigger stripers. The large mouth are still biting off of the shad, which are netable throughout most of the coves on the lake. Elizabeth cyn, dry gulch, and hawks nest are the best places for the shad and a good home for the large mouth and striper. Old SS was the place on Saturday for the boils, from 8am till mid afternoon the stripers were controlling the waters. Lower lake fishing has been ok the past week, decent sized large mouth being reported from the shore and off the boats and float tubes.
