Striper fishing is still doing very well again this week and just keeps getting better. Stripers are still chasing the shad all over the lake but fishermen are doing the best in the fish arm off the points and in the coves such as Old SS and Hawks Nest. The stripers are still getting bigger in size ranging from two to ten pounds. Some of the bigger stripers have been coming off the trolling bite but the shad, and shad imitations and doing the best. The largemouth are still biting on the shad and shad imitations. The largemouth are pretty picky lately and are getting at little harder and harder to catch. The stripers seem be biting best between 6:15 and 10:00 am, then again from 3:00pm till closing. The trout bite at the lower lake is doing excellent and the largemouth reacted well to the plant.
