The Department of Fish and Game will be stocking both the upper lake and lower lagoon this week. To find out if they have planted and which side of the lake they planted on please call the marina at (661)-775-6232. The Striper fishing is still doing ok. We seem to be in a little bit of a slump but most of the catches are still coming off of the shoreline to the right of the marina. Shore fishermen are using anchovies, sardines, night crawlers, shad and blood worms to lure the stripers up. Most of the fish being reported are around 4 to 9 pounds. The largemouth bite has been doing great for weeks now still biting on shad imitations and worms. All of the coves in the fish arm are producing fish. It seems to be a pretty good all day bite but the more dominate times are still in the morning and late evening. The fishing at the lower lagoon has still been pretty good all day and all night. Night crawlers have been working the best and pumpkin colored plastics are doing great as well. Not very many swimbait fish being caught down at the lower lagoon but that doesn't keep the people from trying. The trout fishing doing fantastic on powerbait small spinners and small pieces of night crawlers.
