WEEK ENDING 12/05/2009

The Department of Fish and Game has stocked both the upper lake and lower lagoon with catchable sized rainbow trout. The Striper fishing is still doing ok. We still seem to be in a little bit of a slump and the shoreline fishing is still doing the best for the bigger fish. Shore fishermen are using anchovies, sardines, night crawlers, shad and blood worms to lure the stripers up. Most of the fish being reported are around 4 to 9 pounds. Some double digit stripers are being caught on larger swim baits over on the shoreline of the west ramp. The largemouth bite is still holding strong and has been doing great for weeks. They are still biting on shad imitations and worms as well as some top water baits in the morning hours. All of the coves in the fish arm are producing fish, some large mouth and some stripers. Fishing still seems to be doing the best in the morning and in the late evening. The fishing at the lower lagoon has still been pretty good all day and all night. Night crawlers have been working the best and green and pumpkin colored plastics are doing great as well. The trout fishing are doing fantastic on powerbait small spinners and small pieces of night crawlers. With the upcoming weather forecasted for this week it is also forecasted to be a fantastic week for fishing.
