The fishing has been staying pretty steady over the past few weeks. Still the west ramp and the buoy line are the place's to be to catch the stripers. At the west ramp, trout swimbaits and lures are working to catch the bigger stripers ranging from 8 lbs to double digit fish. At the buoy line the striper bite has been a cut bait bite. Sardines are the best cut bait, anchovies don't seem to working at all. At the west ramp the trout only hang around from about a week or less so they are a little harder to catch at the upper lake. If you're looking for trout, the lower lake is producing a lot of nice sized trout along with some large mouth ranging from 2 to 5 pounds. The large mouth at the upper lake are doing ok, lately it has been a hit or miss kind of thing. It will be doing great for four of five days then the bite just shut off for a day or two. But when the largemouth are biting they are in deeper waters around twenty to thirty five feet.
