Fish has been fantastic all over the lake. Largemouth bass have been doing the best. Almost every cove in the fish arm is producing fish ranging from 1 to 4 pounds with some 5+ pounders showing up here and there. Night crawlers, Robo Worms, Senko's, Berkley Realistic minnows, Storm Minnows, almost anything you can throw out there will catch a fish. The early morning has been producing the better fish but it is an all day bite. Hawks nest and a few of the smaller coves have still been producing nice pan fish which are biting on meal worms and anything small. The Striper bite hasn't really changed much, the buoy line is still doing fantastic on anchovies and sardines as well has the opening of Elizabeth canyon. Not much size to 95% of the stripers but there is the occasional 6 to 10 pounder, the rest are ½ pound to 2 pounders. The moon light fishing did pretty well, lots of small stripers down the down and a very good bass bite. The lower lake has been producing some nice fish as well. Still a very good night crawler bite near the fishing pier. Still no shad yet but there is a lot of small bait near the surface they are just not catchable yet.
