Unfortunately the fishing has been in a slump for the past couple weeks, but the department of fish and game will be stocking the upper lake and lower lagoon this week and will most likely stock it on Monday. So as far as the striper fishing goes it has still been pretty slow. Most of the fish being caught are around 1 to 3 pounds and are being caught in deep water around 80 to 100 feet on cut bait. For the large mouth, it has been a very slow bite as well. Largemouth are being metered in 10 to 35 feet of water but just don't seem to really have an appetite. However the large mouth fishing at the lower lagoon has been fantastic night and day. People are catching large mouth on everything, big and small, from worms to swimbaits. The trout fishing at the lower lagoon is doing very well from the shoreline near the launch ramp all the way up the campsites. The fishing will hopefully change this week so please call for the most up to date report.
