Fishing is still a little slow for this time of year. The bigger striped bass don't really seem to be hanging around the shoreline like they have in the past. The stripers that are being caught are the schoolies ranging from a pound to 3 pounds, and these are fish are being caught on anchovies, sardines, and night crawlers. Some swimbaits have been able to bring up a few bigger stripers from the shoreline near the marina and from the corner of the dam near the tower. Kong island, the fore bay buoy line and Sharron's rest are still the spots to hit for those deep schools of striped bass. The largemouth bass bite is still not doing that great. These bass are very picky and most of them are hanging out in deeper waters so most anglers are trying to catch them on spoons and jigs. The bass that are being found are in the backs of the coves and off the points as usual. Another report of a small mouth came in this week from Kevin Beret, his small mouth weighed about 2 pounds. Kevin caught this fish in 55 feet of water spooning for stripers. Fishing at the lower lake is still holding strong, the largemouth are still biting swimbaits and the trout are still eating the power bait.
