Striper fishing has been picking up a little bit. Small stripers have been schooled up over in Elizabeth Cyn and Sharron's rest. The size to most of these stripers is about 1 to 3 pounds; the bigger stripers are still coming off of the shoreline to the right of the marina and off the dam. The largemouth fishing is still not that great. They are pretty deep and very skittish. Some shad baits and drop shot techniques are working but night crawlers seem to be doing best because the stripers are eating the worms too. The lower lagoon fishing has been doing pretty good still. Largemouth, trout and some panfish are biting all along the shoreline from the spill way to the RV campsites. Unfortunately we will not be getting trout this week.
