WEEK ENDING 02/20/2010

WATER TEMP: Low to High 50's

Still no trout plants scheduled for this up coming week, but that hasn't stopped anglers from catching limits of 1 to 3 pound stripers. Sharron's Rest, Elizabeth Cyn, Kong Island, and the Fore Bay Buoy Line are still the hot spots for the stripers and the sardine/anchovy bite is still the best. There have been a few more reports of stripers being caught off of night crawlers and squid this past week so those are two good back-up baits. The best time for the stripers seems to be in the afternoon, sometime after 3:00pm. As far as the largemouth, most anglers seem to be picking them up around 10 to 25 feet deep, in some spots even deeper. For the most part stick to the darker more natural colors and fish the points and the mouths of the coves. The fishing at the lower lagoon has been pretty consistent the past month or so, lots of decently sized largemouth being caught daily. The best baits are either night crawlers or plastics, some crankbaits have been working but it is still a very strong finesse bite. The catfish bite is doing pretty well at both lakes, Elizabeth Cyn and in the coves around Kong Island are the best spots for the cats. Only a handful of trout catches and they are still being caught on power bait. No panfish to report.
