Both the upper and lower lakes have still been doing a lot better this past week then earlier in the year. The water has cleared up over the past two weeks and now clarity in some areas of the lake is around 20 to 25 feet, here at the marina the water clarity is around 12 to 15 feet. The Large mouth at the upper lake still don't seem to be biting very good but drop shotting a Robo worm or fly lining a senko will usually work for those finicky bass. These bass can still be found around 5 to 25 feet of water in the coves and off of the points. The stripers have been putting on a show every evening in the corner of the dam near the west ramp. Shoreline anglers have been catching the stripers from about 1:00pm till closing and have been bringing up stripers ranging from a pound to 15 pounds. Sardines are still the bait of choice for the shorliners and some of the boat anglers who are catching stripers near Kong Island and at the Fore Bay Buoy line. The largemouth at the lower lake have been doing fantastic as well on small swimbaits like the 6" Spro BBZ and some smaller shad baits like the Sebile Magic Swimmer. These baits have been working around the clock and are bringing in some very nice fish. Not very many trout reports over the course of the week but small spinners and salmon peach power bait are always a great choice.
