WATER TEMP: High 60's Low 70's

The Striper fishing has slowed down a bit from before but for those striper addicts the buoy line is still the place to be. Stripers are being caught throughout the day at the buoy line on fresh dead and frozen sardines. The average size Striper being caught at the moment are between one and three pounds. As far as other spots like Sharron's rest, Kong Island, and Elizabeth Cyn, there haven't been that good of reports. The large mouth fishing has been phenomenal all over the lake on plastics and night crawlers. I recommend getting to the lake upon opening and you'll see some boils right off shore. Other than that it seems to be an afternoon bite. The more natural colored plastics are the way to go, ox blood and arron's magic a great robo worm colors to dropshot. Another plastic I would recommend are the baby bass colored senkos wacky rigged. Large mouth fishing at the lower lagoon has still been very successful pretty much all day. Plastics and night crawlers are also the bait of choice down at the lagoon. For those anglers getting in some night fishing at the lagoon try out the smoked senkos. The pan fish bite has also still been doing very well on wax worms and meal worms.
