## FISHING REPORT

WEEK ENDING 07/10/2010

WATER TEMP: Mid to low 70's

Fishing is still holding strong at both the upper and lower lakes. Stripers at the upper are still biting on anchovies and sardines at the buoy line and near Kong Island. Still not much size to them, most of the stripers are around 1 to 3 pounds but put up a big fight. The trolling bite still hasn't picked up yet but with the shad right around the corner anglers are anxious and ready. The large mouth at the upper lake are still doing great on an array of baits. Night crawlers are the hot ticket around the launch ramp but most of the fish around the ramp still are not legal size yet. Plastics are still always working in the back of almost any cove in the fish arm and in a few coves in the ski arm. Robo's, Senkos, Flukes, and power worms are great choices for plastics. Some top water action still going on in the morning hours but during the evening the top water bite has been even better. Largies, pan fish, and catfish are all biting on night crawlers at the lower lagoon all day long. Still the most productive time for fishing at the lagoon has to be in the early morning hours before the sun comes up.
