The fishing this past week has slowed down a little bit probably due to the weather so with better weather forecasted for this week fishing should pick back up. Stripers are still being caught at the buoy line on dines, chovies, and night crawlers. All day long the stripers randomly bite; no real consistent bite has been shown. The largemouth have also taken a hit this these hotter temps but are still doing better than the stripers. Flukes and Robo's are the best artificial baits, night crawlers and crawdads (Sold at Gallions in town) are the best live bait. These artificial and live baits work at both the upper lake and lower lagoon. Lagoon fishing is doing the best yet again, going off 24/7 for the largemouth and pan fish. Largies are bite on the surface in the mornings and late evening, the mid day bite has been at little deeper and the bass are suspended around 15 to 20 feet. Drop shots and jigs are doing great to get those deeper bass. Still the best bet for the bigger fish has been at night.
