WEEK ENDING 07/24/2010

WATER TEMP: Mid 70's to 80

LOWER LAKE Trout Plant: 01/12/2010

UPPER LAKE Main Ramp 3100 lbs: 05/24/2010

Striper fishing has picked up quite a bit; anglers are snagging 4 to 7 pounders at the buoy line on fresh dead sardines. The schoolie stripers are still hanging around but bigger fish are being brought in. Kong Island and Elizabeth Cyn are not being very productive for striper anglers but in Elizabeth Cyn the large mouth are doing very well. Largemouth can still be found in almost every cove in the fish arm and they are biting night crawlers and plastics still. Good colors to use for Robo worms are Ox blood and Morning Dawn. Some top water baits work in the morning hours as well as spinner baits and chatter baits. At the lagoon the largies are still huge and still biting. There are a lot of unconfirmed reports of double digit largies being caught out of the lower lake still. The bait of choice has been Plastic worms and night crawlers, some top bait have been working but only at specific hours. Pan fish are still doing very well at the lagoon from about 5:30 pm till just after dusk. The bait of choice for the crappie and blue gills are meal worms, wax worms, crappie jigs and tiny pieces of night crawlers. But if you can net a few, the shad are working very well too.
