Fishing is still doing great all over the lake. The largemouth bite is wide open at both the upper and lower lakes. Largies are sticking to biting the night crawlers and other plastic worms. Senko's and Robo's are among the best baits for the largies all day at the upper lake and all night long at the lower lagoon. Stripers have been kicking but at the buoy line and near Kong island. Sardines are still the bait of choice and if you can get fresh dead you're better off. The stripers have been funny though, it seems that boats are either catching their limits or nothing at all. A lot of this can be due to line choice, so choose carefully and step up to fluorocarbon if you still using monofilament line. The catfish bite has been off the hook all over the lake from the buoy line to Elizabeth Cyn. Night crawlers have been working the best but mackerel works great too. Pan fish are still biting at the lagoon on wax and meal worms. Still no sign that the shad are fully up yet most of the bait in the water is still the bass fry but soon enough the shad will be here.
