Most of the largemouth are mid range in size but a few fatties are poppin up in the upper lake and the lagoon is still producing a bunch of Lunkers. Stripers are becoming a lot more active throughout most of the lake. Elizabeth Cyn is full of schoolie stripers looking for night crawlers and sardines, most of which are being caught in 25 to 50 feet of water. The buoy line is hit or miss lately and just isn't as consistent as it has been but Kong Island is still holding strong with largies, cats, and stripers. Mass numbers of cat fish are being brought in everyday. Elizabeth Cyn and Kong Island are the best spots for the cats and they are biting off of the night crawlers as well.
