Striper fishing still hasn't sprung back but the lagoon is hanging in there with big largies over and over. The lagoon these past few months has been absolutely the key place for largemouth. Now the bait of choice for largies at the lagoon is still plastics and night crawlers, but shad imitations at night thru dusk are pulling in some fatties. Finding the largemouth at the upper lake is pretty easy too they are just more picky and pressured. Night crawlers are the way to go on in the coves of the fish arm for most of the morning, then in the afternoon the baits to use are going to be more like top water baits. Spooks, Sammie's, and Flukes are great baits to throwing in the evening hours to close out the day. Stripers haven't really been showing themselves lately but the few that are being caught are around 12 to 15 inches. Catfish fishing is still fantastic and just stick with the night crawlers for them, since it seems to be the bait of choice for most of the lake.
