Fishing is still pretty tough for the stripers all around the lake. The buoy line has been producing a few nice sized stripers every couple of days but overall its slim picking. Kong island and sharrons rest have been doing the best for stripes but it is hit or miss on a day to day basis. Sardines and chovies are the still the best bait but the top water bite is still picking up in the back of the coves. Largemouth are also biting pretty good on the top water in the morning hours and in the mid afternoon. Drop shoting a robo worm or floating a night crawler is another good way to target those picky bass at both the upper and lower lakes. The pan fish at the lagoon were biting pretty well this past week off little Berkley power maggots, wax worms and night crawlers. Some shad balls have been report in a few coves but still no real sign of good shad yet.
