The presence of the shad is starting to wake up the stripers and largies all over the fish arm. Early this past week the shad started showing their faces in coves such as Old SS, Alligator, and Elizabeth Cyn. Most of the stripers being caught are around 1 to 2 pounds but they are hungry. The largies are also responding very well to the shad and are biting on the surface off of flukes and kastmasters. The morning hours are definitely the best as well as the mid afternoon, the late morning bite hasn't been that great unfortunately. Still most of the fish being caught lately don't have much size to them but a few unconfirmed reports of 6 to 10 pound stripers have been circulating through the fish stories lately. Catfish fishing has been doing great throughout most of the fish arm and parts of the ski arm. The lagoon hasn't been producing as many bigger fish as it has been but the numbers are still there. All day and all night largies are busting on top water lures, shad baits and night crawlers.
