With the shad still on the move and the stripers still hunting, top water baits are a must to catch these fish. Stripers have been boiling everyday this past week. From the backs of the coves to the points, from the marina to Elizabeth Cyn, stripers have been boiling in the early morning hours, mid day, and late evening. Spooks, sammy's, rovers, and poppers are wise choices to have rigged up while you're fishing throughout the day. Largies are also jumping in on the action, so use these baits for them as well. Senkos and Robo's are still the best choice for those finicky bass. Most of the largies are decently sized around 2 to 4 pounds but the stripers are little guys, 90% of them ranging from 1 to 2 pounds with a few bigger ones mixed in around 4 to 6 pounds. Night crawlers are still the best bait at the lagoon and the pan fish are back. Meal worms and wax worms are fail safe bait choices for the little crappie and blue gill which can be spotted in the shrubbery hanging in the water.
