WEEK ENDING 09/25/2010

WATER TEMP: High 60's to Mid 70's

LOWER LAKE Trout Plant: 01/12/2010

UPPER LAKE Main Ramp 3100 lbs: 05/24/2010

With all the shad still around the fishing is still doing pretty good. With this most recent warm up it drove the fish down deeper so they haven't been boiling as much but some anglers are spooning for them off the points and are coming up with bigger fish. These fish have been around 6 to 10 pounds while most of the fish caught at the buoy line and off boils are around 1 ½ to 2 pounds. The west ramp is still doing the best for the bigger striper and an abundance of shad waiting to be scooped. Flukes and spooks are still the go to baits for nabbing the stripers and largies. Trolling is another good way to go if you can't find any boils. A lot of anglers are now trolling with the umbrella rigs for the stripers. For the largies, if you can net shad great, but if not plastics are still doing great as usual. You can target the bass all over Elizabeth Cyn and in the coves around Kong Island. The best time of the day is definitely the late afternoon, the early morning is great and the mid day bite is kind of slow but the afternoon bite can't be beat. Lagoon fishing is still hanging in there with a bunch of cats and largies, some pan fish are still being reported.
