Fishing has leveled off and is doing pretty fair. This is most likely due to the fact that the lake went up more than 15 feet this past month. The striper bite has been really tough all throughout the lake. They might still be keying in on the anchovies and sardines, but most anglers are catching them randomly all day on an array of different baits. The largies have been doing a lot better over these last couple weeks. They are still biting the shad imitations all over the fish arm. Necktie Cyn has been the most consistent cove as an all day fishing spot. The largies have been hanging out around 15 to 25 feet deep in the coves but due to a lot new vegetation in the water they have been seen right on the surface swimming threw the bushes. Even with that trout plant on the 21st, the stripers never really keyed in on them so we are going to have to wait another week to see if we get some trout because we are not on the planting schedule for this week. Hopefully the next plant will bring us out of this slump and bring up some stripers.
