Few people have been getting lucky here and there but there really isn't a hot spot for the stripers. They might still bite the anchovies and sardines but throw everything you've got at them. The large mouths are doing better than they have been doing. They are also biting the night crawlers and shad baits still, so you can still find them in their usual spots. The morning bite has been doing a lot better but the afternoon bite has picked up quite a bit.
