The lagoon is doing great near the launch ramp and fishing pier in the evening hours after the sun goes down.

Also, an unconfirmed report of small mouth on the run again, Jimmy (No last name) was in here on Friday and caught 2 decently sized smallies around Kong island. Unfortunately no other info was gathered. Trout fishing will most likely be pretty killer in the later part of the week so just give us a call to find out if we have been stocked with trout.
